2.0: BACKGROUND NOTE (PARISH PROFILE)

Ilembula Parish was officially opened more than 100 years ago by German Missionaries. The Parish has 9 Sub-Parishes (preaching points). The running costs of the Church work depending on Christians members collections for 98%. For this case collections are divided into 4 divisions namely, Diocese, District, Parish and Preaching points (Sub-Parishes).

The parish is located at a distance of 95 Km from Njombe headquarters, 0 Km from Ilembula District headquarters, and 5 Km from Halali feeder road projecting from Dar es Salaam to Mbeya TANZAM Highway.

3.0: STATEMENT OF THE PROBLEM

Being a highly dependent on Church members' collections. Ilembula Parish is built by members from Ilembula, Iggula, Kigingi, Luvande, Ivigo, Kibangada, Ngalanga and Iponda preaching points (Sub-Parishes). A great number of people who make up the Church which build the Parish are poor who depend solely on what the natural climate offers them in form of rainfall for the growth of their agricultural products.

They produce maize, beans and sunflower as their socio-economic base. They have no insurances on what they produce. When natural catastrophes affect their crops,

they suffer from poverty and hunger altogether. For example, there was high levels of poverty and famine in 2019 because of very low amount of harvests resulted from little annual rain, this drought has predominated.

As is built by the poor Christians, Ilembula Parish faces a number of challenges; lacks parish multi-function business house, has high levels of people who are failing to bring good offering to God so as the Church can afford the mission of the Church like supporting power orphans at Schools, Widows, Disabled people, old people and to pay evangelists monthly wages.

4.0: RATIONALE OF THE PROJECT

Strategically measures to have reproductive business are among the most important aspects of Church wealthy. So the multi-function business house is highly demanded by the Church members to fulfill the mission of Jesus Christ.

5.0: IMPLEMENTATION AND SUPERVISION OF THE PROJECT

The project is to be implemented by Parish Construction Committee in collaboration with the Parish Management Team, HA-ILE Partnership Committee.

However, the project will be supervised by the HA-ILE Project Coordinator, District Pastor, Parish Pastor through the Diocesan Technical Officer, who is responsible personnel in building activities in Church buildings for Spiritual services, Education like technical schools also in colleges of all types.

6.0: PROJECT STRUCTURAL LAYOUT PLAN

The multi-function business project consists of two buildings with five rooms each. Construction will be in two steps.

7.0: METHODOLOGY TO ACHIEVE THE PROPOSED PROJECT

To complete the project to its full physical terms, joint efforts amongst different stakeholders are needed in every step of the project. Christians, Evangelists, the Church administrative committees and the local government officials will have to play part in the project.

The Church members will have to prepare the local materials available and needed in the project. They will also have to provide labour in kind in all nontechnical activities of the project.

When completed, the renters will have to maintain both the internal and external cleanliness of the building and ensure that its structures remain intact. Parish leaders will have to organize the Christians' involvement in the project by educating and supervising them to accomplish the project related activities.

The Parish administrative committee under the HA-ILE Coordinator will have to provide feedback reports to the donors at every stage of the project. At the end of the project a comprehensive report will also be provided. The Diocesan Technical

Officer and local Government officials will have to provide technical support and supervision in all stages of the project. They will have to put down their recommendations for improvements of the project in the Church site visitors' log book.

8.0: BENEFICIARIES OF THE PROJECT

When fully realized to its physical terms, the multi-function business house will benefit the Church community, the entire local communities, the Church and government at large.

Examples for using the rooms:

- the parish can offer papaya fruits or other vegetables from its own cultivation
- the church can offer things for the believers
- the hospital can offer things for the patients
- church or hospital can offer health advice
- members of the community can offer different things.

9.0: TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET (A BILL OF QUANTITIES)

The total budget of the project is scheduled to be contributed by Church Members and (donor) in the name of HA-ILE Tansania e.V

The amount contributed by the communities is **Tshs 5,858,000/= (Euro 2.400)** while **the amount requested from donors is Tsh.23, 432,000/= (Euro 9.600)**. So, the wholesome total of the project investment is estimated to be **Tsh.29, 290,000= (Euro 12.000)** - refer the BoQ and drawings attached
