

# VISITATION REPORT DONE IN JANUARY 30, 2021

All Primary Schools which implementing girls' toilets were visited. This year has been a very unique year as there has been a huge effort to build new classroom buildings for pupils. Only a few schools did not have the same strategy of classroom construction work.

The following is a brief report from primary schools which are in the HA-ILE projects.

## 1. KANAMALENGA PRIMARY SCHOOL

The school has one new classroom building. Although is not finished but is in use because of the need.

Toilet built by the Community and HA-ILE is in use. Connected with water and some time the pupils have to fetch for toilet uses for avoiding high cost of water bills to be paid.

## 2. IGELEHEDZA PRIMARY SCHOOL

This is the School which has the highest number of pupils. As they asked HA-ILE to support new classrooms building, the community with Government contributed so as they can overcome the big challenge which was stress the pupils, teachers, parents, community and Government. They built 2 buildings which contains 2 classrooms and teachers each. But they still need more classrooms.



Toilet is in use. But not connected with water. Pupils are fetching from the tape.



### 3. ILEMBULA PRIMARY SCHOOL

The school has a new classroom building which is an additional from other classrooms. It is a contribution from Community and Government.



Toilet built by the Community and HA-ILE is in use but not connected with water. Pupils are fetching from the tap. They are expecting to connect after finalizing the new classroom build work and renovation the very old classrooms.




#### 4. IPONDA PRIMARY SCHOOL

This school has a toilet connected with water since 2018. It is in use. They have a barrel for storing water.



## 5. HANJAVANU PRIMARY SCHOOL

The school toilets in 2020 were seized because of excessive rainfall. With the efforts of the leaders school, parents and Governments succeeded in making amends again. Now toilets are in use. Toilets are connected with water.



## 6. IYAYI PRIMARY SCHOOL

Toilet connected with water and is in use. Some time they lock for avoiding misuse of water by the community when the pupils are not at School.

After this stage, will be flipping the floor, fixing ceiling board, windows, doors and fixing water system, then electricity installati

## **SUMMARY**

This year has had a very encouraging change in developments in schools compared to back years. Schools have had many new things to implement in particular the construction of new CLASSROOMS Buildings, and HA-ILE projects have continued to be well managed. Only a few schools didn't manage properly.

As HA-ILE team, Igelehedza Primary School should be encouraged by giving them support even a small portion of support for example colors, buying seats, etc.

The Village leadership has done a very good job of encouraging citizens to make their contributions for building those two classrooms. Actually, they asked last to be supported but HA-ILE failed because had its priorities.
