- ii. Water is connected with WANGIWASA
- iii. Water is used for Church, guests and people who are living nearby.
- iv. Water is provided free.

The project is not sustainable.

- i. They are not charging any money for the project.
- ii. They do not have a special Committee.

## **HA-ILE SUPERVISION SUPPORTED PROJECTS - SHORT REPORT IN MAY 2019: IGULA**

### **A. IGULA PREACHING POINT**

It belongs to Ilembula Parish, Ilembula District.

The PP lead by Ev. Beatrace Merere. During my visit she was at Mbeya

### **PROJECTS SUPPORTED BY HA-ILE e.V Tansania**

#### **1. WATER PROJECT**

The PP has no water project but nearby there is a Amani Kids Club building has 2 simtanks. Each simtank is full of water 5,000 lts each.



#### **WATER POLICY**

They do not have a written policy of water project, but the project is supervised and controlled by the Church elders.

- i. The key is kept by the PP Evangelist.
- ii. The tape is locked when water is not needed.
- iii. For the time being, water is used for Church and Amani Kids club eg. cleaning, in toilets, cooking
- iv. Water is provided free especially for old people and people with special needs like disabled people other people are not allowed.
- v. For maintenances, they are using money from the PP source of income. They have field/land which used for growing maize, sunflowers, beans and nuts. They have money which is used for this purposes too.

## **SUSTANABILITY OF THE PROJECT**

The project is sustainable for 75%. Although they are not charging but they have another source of money.

Other people are selling water Tsh.400 each 20lts

The Committee is active

### **ADVISE:**

Allow the people to fetch water by paying Tsh.400-500 per 20lts

## **WAYFORWARD**

They will discuss on how much people will pay for water.

## **2. AMANI KIDS CLUB BUILDING**

They project supervised and controlled by the Evangelist with Church



elders.

They are renting to the community for celebration like wedding, confirmation and so on with 2 categories of charges:

- Stakeholders from Igula Tsh.35,000 per day
- Other people from out or within Igula village which are not among of Stakeholders Tsh.50,000

They are gathering twice per month every second Saturday.

They have one teacher named Matrinda Mponji

## CHALLENGES

They are lacking balls for playing.

## B. IGULA PRIMARY SCHOOL

Is belongs to Government. Located at Igula Village, Ilembula ward, Wanging'ombe District and Njombe Region.

## NUMBER OF PUPILS

The School has 334 pupils.186 (56%) male and 148 ( 44%) are females.

## NUMBER OF TEACHERS

They are 9 teachers. 3 (33%) are males and 6 (67%) are females.

## NEW HEAD TEACHER

The first headteacher has been transferred to another school. Now the head of school is Miss Felista Mgaya. She was not present because was attending a special seminar to the ward office.



## SCHOOL COMMITTEE

The school has a School Committee which is supervising all activities at School.



## PROJECTS:

### 1. KITCHEN



It is not use. According to the explanation of the Primary School Assistant Head teacher mr. Mgaya and the cooker Mrs.Rahel

Mwenga. They stated that the butt of pot is broken. For the time being they are using the old kitchen with 3 stones out side.



## WAY FORWARD

They will communicate with Waigosi for repairing.

### 2. WATER PROJECT

They do not have water project supported by the HA-ILE but by the Government. It is connected with WANGIWASA pipes. But water is not available every day.





## WAY FORWARD

Simtanks are needed.

### **PROJECTS SUPPORTED BY HA-ILE e.V Tansania**

#### **1. WATER PROJECT**

The PP has water project installed to Church building. 2 simtanks. Each simtank is 5,000 lts.



All tanks have very few water for along time they had no water from WANGIWASA. They sold nearly all water to the community each 20 lts Tsh.100.

#### **WATER POLICY**

They do not have a written policy of water project, but the project is supervised and controlled by the Church elders.

- i. The key is kept by the PP Evangelist.
- ii. The tap is locked when water is not needed.
- iii. They have specific time to open.





### **SUSTANABILITY OF THE PROJECT**

The project is not sustainable for 70%

- i. They are charging very little money. But in Tanzania we have a saying “Little is better than nothing” it means for charging even a little money they are earning some benefit.
- ii. Water is not connected to pipes from main pipe belongs to Government

### **WAY FORWARD**

- i. They will discuss on how they can making charges to the community for the sustainability of the project, example to increase amount of money for water
- ii. They will connect to main pipe line if the WANGIWASA allows.

The project has water committee of 6 members. They do not have a committee deals only for water project but deals with preaching point building construction. The project is controlled and supervised by the preaching point secretary Mwl. Beth Simon.

The tap has a lock. They have specific time to open.

## **SUSTANABILITY OF THE PROJECT**

The project is not sustainable.

- i. They are not charging any money for the project. Other people from the community are selling water: 20lts is Tsh.500. It means for the PP water project will earn Tsh.250, 000 just a once. If they will harvest 2 times per year it means they will earn Tsh.500,000. This is just an example I explained to them.
- ii. They have not connected water pipes from main pipe belonging to Government

## **WAY FORWARD**

- i. They decided to discuss with the committee, church leaders and the whole members on how they can make charges to the community for the sustainability of the project.
- ii. They will connect to main pipe line.

The School has 1008 pupils. 482 (48%) male and 526 (52%) are females.

They are 14 teachers. 5 (36%) are males and 9 (64%) are females.

The school has a School Committee which is supervising all activities at School.

#### PROJECTS:

##### 1. KITCHEN



They have 1 metal stove but it needs a little repair of the smoke pipe (refer the red arrow). They are 2 cookers.

2 loam stove. Both are working and are in use. The red arrow shows the equipment used to clean, taking out fire ashes and so on.

For the start of using the toilet any time, they have bought 2 big plastics which comprises 50 lts each and 5 medium plastics which is 10lts each and other toilets equipment like plastic cups as you can see the red arrow.

The toilets are not in use and no connection from the main pipe yet.
