A. IYAYI PARISH

Is belongs to Ilembula District. The whole Parish has 1802 church members. Adults are 1182, male 452 and female 730. Children are 620, male 283 and female 337.

PROJECTS SUPPORTED BY HA-ILE e.V Tansania

1. WATER PROJECT

They have 3 Simtanks installed to the church building. 2 tanks are full of water. 1 empty. Has a problem. I informed the Engineer from NT Network to repair. He promised to repair on 17th of May,2019



WATER POLICY

The project has water committee of 6 members. The project is controlled and supervised by committee.



The tap has a lock. They have specific time to open.

They are not charging any money for the project.

They have not connected water pipes from main pipe belongs to Government

WAY FORWARD

They will discuss on how they can making charges to the community for the sustainability of the project.

2. TOILET PROJECT

It is in finishing level. All materials are purchased like cement and doors are made, they have planned to fix them.

They have 2 kinds of toilet and users:



Toilet for Parish Officers. They have planned to have a special door/entrance as you can see from the photo. Also you can see those doors for fixing to toilets doors.



Public toilet will be in another side. They have started to fix toilets sinks refer the photos.

The started to construct in 2013. Now it is 6 years. It is their hope that this year the toile will be finished

3. KINDERGARTEN

There are 16 children. Male 5 and female 11.Each child paying Tsh.100,000 per year, each month is Tsh.8,333 each child. The total school fee from 16 children is Tsh.1,600,000. The school has only 1 teacher called Rehema Festo Mpangwa.

They have planned to employ another teacher. But the challenge is payments. Each month they must pay Tsh.200,000 to 2 teacher. For the time being, there are 2 teachers from Kanamalenga Parish who are having training to be teacher.

B. IYAYI PRIMARY SCHOOL

Is belongs to Government. Located at Iyayi Village, Luduga ward, Wanging'ombe District and Njombe Region.

NUMBER OF PUPILS

The School has 433 pupils.227 (52%) male and 206 (48%) are females.

NUMBER OF TEACHERS

They are 6 teachers. 5 (83%) are males and 1 (17%) are females. The needed teachers according to the ration compared by the number of pupils are 10. Missing are 4 teachers.

SCHOOL COMMITTEE

The school has a School Committee which is supervising all activities at School.

PROJECTS:

1. KITCHEN





It is in use. -The building is plastered, no doors and windows.

According to the explanation of the Primary School Head teacher Mr. Seth Simon Mlonganile, the Village Chairperson Mr. Roden Wihanji, Mr. Fadhili Lamba-Member from the School Committee, they told me that Mr. Sikilo (stove fundi) visited and observed the challenges of metal pot which has damaged, now they are using the old pot which too big to fix to the loam stove. For that case they are using the outside kitchen.





2. WATER PROJECT

Simtanks not connected with Government water pipe. They have send application to WANGIWASA. They are waiting to connect. From the above photo you can see head teacher showing the direction of where to connect.



3. TOILET PROJECT

The toilets are not in use. They are waiting water connection as stated above.

4. LIVESTOCK KEEPING

They have 2 cows. All are going well.

Is belongs to Government. Located at Hanjavu Village, Luduga ward, Wanging'ombe District and Njombe Region. Is located at west of Ilembula 9.5kms from Ilembula Parish.

NUMBER OF PUPILS

The School has 134 pupils.74 (55%) male and 60 (45%) are females.

NUMBER OF TEACHERS

They are 5 teachers. All are males. 1 is volunteering.

SCHOOL COMMITTEE

It comprises 13 members.8 (62%) are males while 5 (38%) females.

PROJECTS:

1. KITCHEN





It is in use.

-The building is not plastered and no doors, stands/bricks which built in the hole of the loam stove are broken. According to the explanation of the Primary School Chairperson, Village Executive Officer, Deputy Head teacher and other members Mr.Sikilo visited and observe the challenge, repaired but the problem still existing. Not easy to make strong.

Request from the committee: -To have metal stoves.

2. WATER PROJECT

- -The school is nearby the main pipeline of WANGIWASA
- -Water is not available always, especially during dry season they do not have water.
- -Is not connected to toilets.

3. TOILET PROJECT

It is in use and good condition.





The pupils are fetching water by the plastics and storing into plastics.

REQUEST FROM THE COMMITTEE: 2 Simtanks is needed for toilet, every room needs a tape water for washing hands and clearing the rooms so as they can avoid contamination.

4. LIVESTOCK KEEPING

They had 3 cows.1 is sold for purchasing and installing solar power to teachers office. Now they have 2 cows and going well.

5. FORESTAL PROJECT

They established forest growth to their school area which was lacked or had few trees. They have tried to plant although are facing problem of dryness during dry season especially in September to November each year.

A. IGANDO PREACHING POINT

Is belongs to Iyayi Parish. It has approximately 40 members. The Village has approximately 800 inhabitants with two religious namely Islamic and Christianity with 4 denominations namely Lutheran Church, Roman Catholic Church, Tanzania Assembles of God (TAG) and Seventh Days Adventist (SDA).

WATER POLICY

They have also water from main pipe belongs to Government

HIGHLY NEED OF WATER

From July to November each year, they are facing a challenge of the shortage of water. They are fetching from different sources like Madunda, Mbogayilongwe, Mabaloni and Makale. Women have to take 2 hours from Igando Village to the places where water are found by digging underground/mud.

Women are able to fetch only once per day, because they have to travel long distance.

REQUEST:

They are requesting to have 2 more Simtanks which can be installed to Evangelists house (house belongs to the church).

They will realize the water committee

They will discuss on how they can make charges to the community.

The School has 178 pupils.95 (53%) male and 83 (47%) are females.

NUMBER OF TEACHERS

They are 9 teachers. 7 (78%) are males and 2 (22%) are females.

SCHOOL COMMITTEE

The school has a School Committee which is supervising all activities at School.

PROJECTS:

1. KITCHEN



It is in use. The building is plastered, no doors and windows.



Stove: According to the explanation of the Primary School Assistant Head mistress Upendo Mwaibanje, Mr. Linus Mwakilambo, Mr.Joseph Shipimo and Luka Ndondole, fundi Mr.Sikilo visited and observed the challenges which was faced. He repaired but there are some damaged. Not easy to make strong.

REQUEST from the committee: To have metal stoves.

2. WATER PROJECT

Simtanks not connected with Government water pipe.

Gutters are thinner than the amount of water falls

They are not repairing the disconnected gutters since last year.



3. TOILET PROJECT

The toilets are built by Government BUT are not in good standard. Not privacy. No water inside and there is just a hole





REQUEST

Toilet project with high quality like other schools is needed Simtanks for toilets water is needed.

4. LIVESTOCK KEEPING

They have 2 goats.

5. FORESTAL PROJECT

They established forest growth to their school area which was lacked or had few trees. They planted fruits trees like guavas and other trees for the shadow during sunny although they are facing problem of dryness during dry season especially in July to November each year.

They have planned every Christian member to contribute Tsh.3,000 as a capital for running costs. This will be kept to the Bank (They have planned to have a special bank account soon as possible).

CHALLENGES FROM SIMTANKS

Gutters are too small other water are jumping/lost

WAY FORWARD

- They are asking to change the gutters. To fix the bigger one
- They will open the Bank account soon.
- They will start to charge. This will be decided during the meeting of Church members
- They will connect water from the drilled well to Simtanks

2. WATER PROJECT SUPPORTED BY HA-ILE: WELL and DRILLED WATER

- They have a committee
- They have dug the canal from the drilled well to school and to the preaching point.
- They have enough water. The pupils are not facing any problem.
